

Required Notification to Employees of the Availability of Unemployment Compensation

Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits are available to workers who are unemployed and who meet the requirements of state UI eligibility laws. You may file a UI claim in the first week that employment stops or work hours are reduced.

You will need to provide the Mississippi Department of Employment Security (MDES) with the following information for the state to process your claim:

1. Your full legal name;
2. Your Social Security Number; and
3. Your authorization to work (if you are not a U.S. Citizen or resident.)

The unemployment claim application requires additional information not listed above.

- To file a UI claim online, visit our website, <https://mdes.ms.gov/unemployment-claims/>. Filing online is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- To file a UI claim by phone, call 601-321-6000 during normal business hours. You will need to speak with a customer service representative/agent in order to file a claim by phone.
